



Terms and Conditions: Best Poster Award Eurobiotech 2017

Definitions:

Organizer: Targi w Krakowie with its registered office in Krakow, 9 Galicyjska Str., postal code: 31-586, NIP (tax ID no.): 6761050090, registered in the District Court for Krakow-Śródmieście in Krakow, 11th Division of the National Court Register under KRS No. 0000192313 - organizer of the 6th Central European Congress of life Sciences Eurobiotech 2017.

Entrant: a person who enters the competition, competitor.

Prize/Prizes: covering the cost of the participation fee (early bird) in the European Congress on Biotechnology 2018 (which will be held in Geneva on July, 1-4); prizes are founded by Organizer.

Conference: 6th Central European Congress of Life Sciences EUROBIOTECH 2017 which will be held in Krakow (Poland) on September 11-14th, 2017.

Jury: a group of persons chosen to adjudge prizes in the competition; the Scientific Committee will act as jury; Professor Tomasz Twardowski is the chairman of the jury.

Terms and conditions:

1. The competition „Best Poster Award“ is organized by Targi w Krakowie Ltd.
2. The competition „Best Poster Award“ aims to select the authors of the 3 best posters from those presented during Eurobiotech 2017.
NOTE: Those who would like to apply for the best poster award, are kindly ask to put the sentence: „The best poster award“ in the upper right corner of the abstract submitted via: eurobiotech2017.ptbioch.edu.pl platform and on the printed poster. Posters without this sentence will not be taken into account.
3. Closing date for entry will be 16th of June 2017. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
4. Entry is open to persons who meet the following criteria:
 - a) have submitted an abstract through: eurobiotech2017.ptbioch.edu.pl;
 - b) have registered for the Eurobiotech 2017 conference;
 - c) are “Young Scientists” (not older than 35 during the Congress, for PHD - within 2 years of PHD qualification);
 - d) have put „The best abstract award“ in the upper right corner of the submitted abstract and on the poster.

5. There is no extra entry fee to take part in this competition.
6. Use of a false name or address will result in disqualification.
7. Only one entry will be accepted per person. Multiple entries from the same persons will be disqualified.
8. The organizer reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice, in case of catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the organizer's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the organizer.
9. The prize is as follows: covering the cost of the participation fee (so called "early bird registration") in the European Congress on Biotechnology 2018 (which will be held in Geneva on July, 1-4) for 3 first authors. The prize cannot be exchanged. Winner may waive the prize. In such case the jury will select another winner. Value of the prize 1 euros.
Note: Prize implies no obligation by the Organizer to cover accommodation, travel expenses, or any other costs connected with participation in the meeting.
10. The winners will automatically get the additional money prize in the amount of 10% market value of the prize, which will be used to cover the 10% flat-rate income tax from individuals of the prize pursuant to the Article 30 item 1 point 2 of the Personal Income Tax Act of 26 July 1991 (Journal of Laws 2012 pos. 361) due to winning in competitions, obtained in a Member State of the European Union or another country belonging to the European Economic Area, see: Article 21 item 1, points 6, 6a and 68. Tax payable by the Organizer.
11. Winners will be chosen by panel of judges. All posters will be assessed by the jury during two poster sessions scheduled in the Conference Programme.
12. When choosing the winner will be taken into consideration:
 1. novelty and innovation of presented research;
 2. potential impact of the results on the development of the research field and scientific discipline;
 3. possible economic and societal impact;
 4. substantive corrected style of data presentation;
 5. style and manner of data presentation;
 6. aesthetic/beauty of poster presented.
13. The winners will be announced and they will collect diplomas during Closing Ceremony of the Conference.

14. The organizer will notify in writing as soon as possible the winner about the technical details of prize collected.
